Dear Orlando Rainey,

Last night the Senate unanimously passed S. 193, Senator Brownback's broadcast indecency fines bill. Thanks to your participation in our grass-roots campaign, the bill included no fines on performers. The bill does increase fines on broadcasters, but omits language that would have imposed significant fines on performers. Despite many Senators looking for more punitive indecency fines in the wake of the Janet Jackson incident, individual performers will not be fined in the legislation passed by the Senate.

We would like to thank you for your support on this issue. Through our grass-roots campaign, you helped generate hundreds of letter to numerous Senators. By making your opinions known, we were able to successfully prevent anti-performer language into the indecency bill. We sincerely thank you for your help.
