An Important Message Regarding Delta Airlines

For several years, the AFM has been monitoring complaints concerning the difficulties members encounter carrying instruments onto airplanes. By far the majority of the complaints have been about Delta Airlines. The AFM has attempted to bring our concerns to Delta through the Air Transport Association (ATA), the US Congress, and also by directly contacting Delta representatives.

Assurances that our concerns would be addressed have produced no improvements. In fact, the rate of complaints about Delta has increased in recent months. Therefore, we urge Federation members to boycott travel on Delta until the airline allows musicians to carry instruments into the cabin of its planes.
